Career and Technical Education Graduate Certificate-This graduate level program provides the opportunity to earn an Initial CTE Certification - Route 2: Business and Industry. This certificate will allow the program completer to teach in grades 7-12 in their specialized and certificated career and technical education area in this identified high need area as identified by the State of Washington.

The Graduate Certificate Plan Requirements

- 6,000 hours of verifiable occupational experience over the past ten years.
- Complete EWUs approved Initial CTE Certificate Plan 2 Business and Industry Route program.
- Must take the WEST-B or SAT/ACT with reading, writing and math prior to program completion.

When students complete the Graduate Certificate program, they will qualify for a Washington State Career and Technical Education Initial Certificate to teach in grades 7–12, ONLY within their certificate Vcode (Route 2: Business and Industry).
