

TELEHEALTH CERTIFICATE, GRADUATE

This graduate certificate is a fully online 16 quarter credit program. This is designed for healthcare managers and practitioners who wish to explore career options in telehealth.

Telehealth technologies and strategies are increasingly being implemented to provide access to medical, dental, rehabilitative, and mental health services. The Graduate Telehealth Certificate provides healthcare professionals with an overview of telehealth best practices and the role of telehealth to improve access to healthcare services, utilization of services, and health outcomes. Emphasis is on how telehealth can be implemented across the healthcare disciplines to meet the health care needs of the most vulnerable populations.

Course work results in a personal toolkit that the student may use as they seek opportunities for working in telehealth within their chosen profession.
