

CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION (CTE) CERTIFICATE, UNDERGRADUATE

Career and Technical Education Undergraduate Certificate-Plan 2

Business and Industry Route teacher certification is a short program for teacher candidates who possess 6,000 hours of paid industry work experience in a specific area. The certificate allows teacher candidates to teach only in that area. There are two undergraduate options within the Plan 2 route. Plan 2 A is a clock-hour only program. Plan 2 B allows students to earn Post Baccalaureate credit.

The Plan 2 Requirements

- 6,000 hours of verifiable occupational experience over the past ten years.
- Complete EWUs approved Plan 2 Business and Industry Route program.
- Must take the WEST-B or SAT/ACT with reading, writing, and math prior to program completion.

When you complete the Plan 2 program, you will qualify for a Washington State Career and Technical Education certificate to teach in grades 7–12, ONLY within your certificate V-code. You will also receive V-codes for work-site learning and career choices. Visit the OSPI (<https://www.k12.wa.us>) website for further details.
