CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION, MASTER OF EDUCATION (M.ED)

Initial Career and Technical Education Certificate - M.Ed.- This graduate level program provides the opportunity to attain an Initial CTE Certification Route 2: Business and Industry along with your Master in Education degree. Candidates who complete this program are eligible for jobs at skill centers and secondary education teachers (grades 7-12) in their specialized CTE area in this high need area identified by the State of Washington.

This program requires a 60-hour internship. Review the graduate internship page for more information.

The MEd Plan Requirements

- 6,000 hours of verifiable occupational experience over the past ten years.
- Complete EWUs approved Initial CTE Certificate Plan 2 Business and Industry Route program.
- Must take the WEST-B or SAT/ACT with reading, writing and math prior to program completion.

When students complete the MEd program, they will qualify for a Washington State Initial Career and Technical Education certificate to teach in grades 7–12, ONLY within their certificate V-code (Route 2: Business and Industry). Visit the OSPI (https://www.k12.wa.us/)website for further details. This will not result in a general Washington State residency teaching certificate.
