This one-year, 41 credit hour course of study provides an opportunity for graduates of the EWU undergraduate Urban and Regional Planning to obtain an accredited master with advanced standing.

Advanced standing may also be possible for graduates of other closely-related undergraduate programs – please consult with the Urban and Regional Planning Graduate Advisor.
